

Reflection for Today

Jesus’ public ministry lasted only about a thousand days. He had so many places to be—so many people who wanted to experience his healing and hear his words. In today’s Gospel, he chooses and commissions 72 disciples to help him spread the saving word of God to more distant lands, to more and more people. He sends them out in pairs. The harvest is plenty, the laborers are few. The numbers of people in need are overwhelming. Jesus instructed these chosen disciples to cure the sick in his name, and to announce the kingdom of God. They were not to concern themselves with whether they preached to sinners or saints, Jews or Gentiles—the message of salvation is intended for all to hear and heed.

In order to make disciples for Jesus, we must first become true disciples of Jesus. By our baptism, we are sent out to all the world to proclaim the same message of forgiveness and hope first entrusted to the Apostles, and then to the 72. We carry the same risks, but may also share the promise of the same reward. We are empowered to do so in as much as we believe, as Isaiah prophesied, that God loves us with the tender care and protection of a doting parent. With the power of God to guide us, no harm can come to us.

Loving God, forgiveness seems like such a simple thing, but when I examine my heart I find that I really don’t want to forgive those who have hurt or offended me. Yet Jesus teaches in the “Our Father” that I will only be forgiven in the same way I forgive others. Help me to make the “personal choice, the decision of the heart” to go against my instinct to nurture hurts and offences, “to pay back evil with evil.” Amen.
