Broadcasting Mases from St. Mary's Parish

The parish has installed an FM transmitter that will be used during scheduled Masses. Due to CRTC regulations, the output must be of low power. Due to the concrete nature of our church building our signal will only carry about a kilometre. You may wish to park your vehicle in the lower parking lot of the church to tune in to any of the scheduled Masses from St. Mary's at a frequency of 88.5 MHz FM.



Masks Mandatory

As a directive from the Renfrew County Health Unit, non-surgical masks became mandatory in certain enclosed spaces (including churches) in Renfrew County. Exceptions include very young children and people with respiratory problems. Medical authorities are asking everyone to be kind to people who are not wearing a mask. They may have a valid reason for not wearing one.
