

**REFLECTION FOR THE DAY**

The Book of Psalms is a treasure of sacred scripture. And it is necessary to make the Psalms *our* prayer. We must ourselves, in a sense, become the psalmist, making these words our own and praying with them. If there are Psalms, or just verses, that speak to our heart, it is good to repeat them and pray them during the day. The Psalms are prayers “for all seasons”: in various life situations we find in them the best words to be transformed into prayer.

If we feel oppressed by guilt, because we are sinners, we can repeat with David: “Have mercy on me, O God, according to thy steadfast love”, Psalm 51. If we want to express a strong personal desire for the Lord, we can repeat: “O God, thou art my God, I seek thee, my soul thirsts for thee; my flesh faints for thee, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water”, Psalm 63. And if fear and anguish assail us, those wonderful words of Psalm 23 come to our rescue: “The Lord is my shepherd ... Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil”. God himself gives us these inspired words of prayer that in every circumstance of life we may draw near to him.

**Rev Michael Brehl, C.S.s.R. named the 10<sup>th</sup> Bishop of Pembroke.** With great cause for rejoicing, I announce that our Holy Father, Pope Francis has named Rev Michael Brehl, C.S.s.R. as the 10<sup>th</sup> Bishop of Pembroke. Fr. Brehl was born in Toronto in 1955 and entered the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorists) in 1975. He professed vows as a Redemptorist on August 15, 1976, and was ordained priest on March 15, 1980. Fr. Brehl currently serves as Provincial Superior of the Canadian Province of the Redemptorists, a role that he held for the Edmonton-Toronto Province from 2002-2009. In addition to many years in parish ministry, preaching missions and the formation of novices, Fr Brehl served two terms as the Redemptorist Superior General in Rome from 2009-2022. **The episcopal ordination and canonical possession will take place at the Cathedral of St. Columbkille in Pembroke on Thur, Aug 15, 2024, the solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, at 10:00 am.**
