“On the first day of the week, at early dawn, the women who had accompanied Jesus from Galilee came to the tomb.”

The women came to the tomb early that Sunday morning carrying spices with which to complete the anointing of Jesus' body which had been hastily entombed on the eve of the Sabbath two days ago. They had come to continue their grieving as they were planning to complete this last act of service for their beloved Teacher.

The tomb indeed is a place of grief and questioning. Like these women, we too encounter such places in our lives. Many experiences in life, that are perhaps as unexpected, as they are difficult, leave us, as it were, before the tomb. Wondering why things happened the way they did?



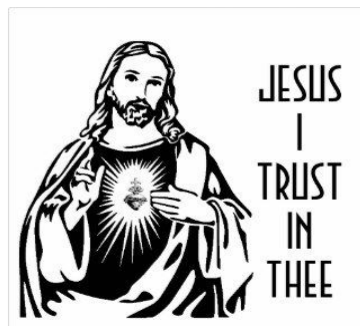
